Audubon Retreat for 5th Graders – October 14th-16th

Cost of coach buses likely very similar to cost of buses/trailer. Coach buses hold 54 people/bus. Native American liaison returns to Skyview for 1 day of the retreat to teach those students who remained behind Native American crafts. Students have said that they "feel changed" after their experience.
